

## MEMBER REGISTRATION FEES and CATEGORIES

Every individual involved in club activities (even if only once) must complete registration in the Interpodia membership database. Members must use the online system to register and complete a payment transaction to one of the following categories:

Category	Definition	2020-2021 Season
Elite	A skater who competes in International and/or domestic competitions (SSC National Championships – Age Class, Junior, Senior) Qualifiers, Canada Cups, North Americans, Canada Winter Games and selection events in Canada.	115 BC fee <u>63 SSC fee</u> <b>\$178</b>
Competitive	A skater who competes in any other SSC or Branch sanctioned competition.	95 BC fee <u>42 SSC fee</u> <b>\$137</b>
Recreational	Any skater who participates in practices but <u>does not compete</u> at competitions.	75 BC fee <u>21 SSC fee</u> <b>\$96</b>
Associate (Coach, Official, Volunteer)	Coaches, officials, administrators, chaperones and all parents and volunteers who help with any club activities and who do not participate as a skating member.	19 BC fee <u>6.50 SSC fee</u> <b>\$25.50</b>
Introductory	A new speed skater taking part in a “learn to skate” program (maximum 10 sessions) either consecutively or weekly. An introductory skater may compete in <u>one</u> home-ice sanctioned event. NOTE: a skater may only register in this category <u>once</u> .	19 BC fee <u>6.50 SSC fee</u> <b>\$25.50</b>
Special Event	SE skater is anyone who takes part in a <u>one time</u> club activity, excluding sanctioned competitions. SE volunteer is anyone who helps <u>one time</u> only at any club event.	2 BC fee <u>1 SSC Fee</u> <b>\$3</b>
